

ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 959.02, 959.03, AND 959.10 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, RELATIVE TO THE RATES FOR REFUSE COLLECTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 959.02 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

959.02 CONTAINERS.

(a) It shall be the duty of each householder or commercial establishment in or upon premises within the Village where garbage and rubbish is accumulated, or allowed to be, to procure and keep available for the exclusive use of such premises or the part thereof occupied by the householder or commercial establishment metal or durable plastic containers; **SUCH CONTAINERS SHALL EITHER BE OBTAINED FROM THE VILLAGE OR, IF OBTAINED ELSEWHERE, MUST BE EQUIVALENT TO THOSE CURRENTLY AVAILABLE FROM THE VILLAGE IN TERMS OF COMPOSITION, CAPACITY, DIMENSIONS, CONFIGURATION, WHEELS, HANDLES, AND FUNCTIONALITY**, or plastic bags which are of thirty-two gallon capacity or less, and which when filled weigh not more than sixty pounds. (Plastic bags shall not be filled beyond their strength). Containers shall have close fitting lids and be provided with bails or handles.

(b) All cans or plastic bags of garbage and rubbish must be put at the curb line for pick up on route day except when a holiday falls on the day of pick up. The day of pick up, in such cases, will be indicated in the newspaper.

For "Tier I" customers weekly pick up is limited to a maximum of six (6) bags, or three (3)

32-GALLON cans, OR ONE 96-GALLON CONTAINER;

for "Tier II" customers weekly pick up is limited to a maximum of nine (9) bags, or four

(4) 32-GALLON cans, OR TWO 96-GALLON CONTAINERS;

FOR "TIER III" CUSTOMERS WEEKLY PICK UP IS LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF TWELVE (12) BAGS, OR SIX (6) 32-GALLON CANS, OR THREE (3) 96-GALLON CONTAINERS;

FOR "SENIOR" CUSTOMERS WEEKLY PICK UP IS LIMITED TO TWO (2) BAGS OR ONE (1) 35-GALLON CAN;

FOR "ULTRA-LIGHT CUSTOMERS WEEKLY PICK UP IS LIMITED TO ONE (1) 65-GALLON CAN (WHICH WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE VILLAGE).

However, a customer may make advance arrangements with the Village for additional or special pickups, at an additional charge. A charge of **TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$2.50) ~~two dollars (\$2.00)~~** per extra bag, and **FOUR DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$4.50) ~~four dollars (\$4.00)~~** per extra can will be assessed.

(c) All boxes, paper bags, and etc. not placed in garbage cans or bags will not be picked up, unless the customer has made advanced arrangements with the additional or special pickups, at an additional charge.

(d) No person shall remove any garbage from any premises occupied by a householder or commercial establishment except the Collector; provided, however, that, a householder

may make alternate arrangements for lawful removal of garbage, but that such arrangements shall not exempt such householder from liability for any charges payable under Section 959.10.

(e) No garbage, trash or any other items to be picked up by the Village of New London Sanitation Department shall be placed upon the tree lawn or curb any sooner than 1:00 p.m. on the day preceding the scheduled pick up.

(f) All empty trash containers, belonging to residents of the Village of New London shall be removed from the tree lawn or curb no later than 8:00 a.m. the day following the scheduled pick up.

Section 2. That 959.03 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

959.03 COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF JUNK, CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS, TRIMMINGS AND FREON-CONTAINING APPLIANCES.

(a) The collection of junk defined in Section 959.01(c) will only be picked up by calling the Sanitation Department. A minimum charge of four dollars (\$4.00) will be assessed if picked up on regular pick up day.

(b) Construction materials defined in Section 959.01(d) will be picked up at the discretion of the Village Administrator or by private haulers. A fee will be established at the time by the Village Administrator for pick ups made by the Village.

(c) Leaves, trees and brush trimmings defined in Section 959.01(c) can be picked up curb side by residents calling the Village Office requesting a pickup at a minimum charge of sixty-seven dollars and fifty-three cents (\$67.53) per hour; or village residents can haul and dispose of yard waste at the village compost facility for free.

(d) Clean up. A spring clean up **MAY will** be held ~~for 2 weeks~~, **AT THE DISCRETION OF THE VILLAGE**, ~~during the month of April~~, where the Village will provide resident access to dumpsters to be located at the Village garage in which residents can dispose of unwanted waste. Dates, time and rules for spring clean up will be posted on the Village's website and facebook page.

(e) Provided that it continues to have the means in place for their final disposal, with notice to the Village by the resident, the Village will collect discarded Freon-containing appliances formerly used on the premises; a surcharge, to reflect the village's actual direct costs in pick up and disposal of the appliance, will be added to the resident's regular garbage bill for this service.

Section 3. That 959.10 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

959.10 RATES FOR COLLECTION.

(a) (1) **FOR "ULTRA-LIGHT" CUSTOMERS, EACH AND EVERY HOUSEHOLDER AND/OR PERSON, APARTMENT BUILDING AND TRAILER PARK ACCUMULATING GARBAGE OR RUBBISH WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON SHALL PAY TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) PER DWELLING UNIT PER MONTH FOR COLLECTION THEREOF.**

For Tier 1 customers, each and every householder and/or person, apartment building and trailer park accumulating garbage or rubbish within the Village of New London shall pay **TWENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS**

(\$27.75) PER DWELLING UNIT ~~Twenty-Six Dollars and Forty-two cents (\$26.42)~~ per month for collection thereof. Residential customers are automatically setup as "Tier 1" customers, but may voluntarily upgrade to Tier II by contacting the Village Office. **SUCH CHANGES ARE LIMITED TO ONCE PER 12-MONTH PERIOD.**

For Tier II customers, each and every householder and/or person, apartment building and trailer park accumulating garbage or rubbish within the Village of New London shall pay **TWENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$28.57) PER DWELLING UNIT ~~twenty nine dollars and fifty seven cents (\$29.57)~~** per month for collection thereof. "Tier II" customers shall have at least one can with an identification sticker provided by the Village that will identify the customers as a Tier II customer.

FOR TIER III CUSTOMERS, EACH AND EVERY HOUSEHOLDER AND/OR PERSON, APARTMENT BUILDING AND TRAILER PARK ACCUMULATING GARBAGE OR RUBBISH WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON SHALL PAY TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FORTY-TWO (\$29.42) PER DWELLING UNIT-PER MONTH FOR COLLECTION THEREOF.

Payments should be made to the Clerk-Treasurer by the **FIFTEENTH~~tenth~~** of the month. A ten percent (10%) penalty shall be added to any bill not paid by the **FIFTEENTH~~tenth~~** of the month.

(2) Any householder, **BEING A ~~having only~~ Senior Citizens (65 or older)WHO IS A TITLED OWNER AND CURRENT RESIDENT OF THE PREMISES** using said collection service **MAY APPLY FOR "SENIOR" COLLECTION SERVICE, FOR COLLECTION OF ONLY A SINGLE THIRTY-FIVE GALLON CAN EACH MONTH, AND** shall be charged at the rate of eighteen dollars and ninety cents (\$18.90) per month. Each **SUCH HOUSEHOLDER ~~senior-citizen~~** in order to qualify for reduced rate must register at the Village Office. **A CHARGE OF TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$2.50) SHALL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH EXTRA BAG OUTSIDE THE CAN.**

(3) An additional surcharge for the pickup of non-standard quantities of leaves, tree and brush trimmings may be assessed by the Administrator to recover the Village's additional costs, and, normally, shall be at the rate of **SEVENTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FORTY-SIX CENTS (\$74.46) ~~seventy dollars and ninety one cents (\$70.91)~~** per hour for time expended in such collection.

(4) A surcharge of **ONE DOLLAR AND SEVEN CENTS (\$1.07) ~~two dollars and cents (\$2.40)~~** per month shall be assessed for any collections made outside the Village.

(5) The Village will make available for purchase for the convenience of residents up to three ninety-**SIX~~five~~ (96~~95~~)** gallon totes per residence.

A. Purchase price per tote shall be ninety-eight dollars (\$98.00), payable prior to the release of each tote;

B. Following the purchase of **MULTIPLE ~~two~~ totes, THE ACCOUNT HOLDER MUST ALSO REGISTER FOR THE APPROPRIATE TIER AS DESCRIBED HEREIN ~~if a third tote is purchased, the increase in anticipated volume shall result in an automatic surcharge of eight dollars and fifty cents (\$8.50) per month for that residence;~~**

~~C. Each tote will be issued with a serial number recorded by the Village;~~

D. The Village will provide a ten (10)-year limited replacement warranty for each tote, limited as follows:

(i) The value of the warranty shall be prorated based on the number of full years remaining since the tote has been put in service;

(ii) To redeem the warranty on a tote and obtain a replacement, the resident shall pay the Village the full purchase price at that time, less an allowance for the remaining ten (10) years, as described in (i)

Example: If tote has been in service for seven (7) years;

Resident shall be charged the current purchase price for a replacement, less thirty percent (30%);

(iii) A tote may not be returned or redeemed for cash;

(iv) No warranty or credit shall be provided where the tote has been damaged other than by normal wear and tear;

(v) No other warranty, express or implied is made by the Village.

E. THE VILLAGE WILL ALSO MAKE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE 35-GALLON TOTES FOR \$55.00 EACH, AND 65 GALLON TOTES FOR \$75 EACH.

F. 35-GALLON CANS MAY BE RENTED FROM THE VILLAGE AT AN ADDITIONAL ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) PER MONTH.

(b) Each and every business or commercial establishment that accumulates garbage and/or rubbish within the Village shall be billed a collection rate based on a flat rate per month and/or based upon the size of dumpster as determined by the Village Administrator, **AS SET FORTH BELOW**. A surcharge of **ONE DOLLAR AND SEVEN CENTS (\$1.07) ~~two dollars and forty cents (\$2.40)~~** per month shall be assessed for any collections made outside the Village.

Any time that a filled dumpster exceeds the weight allowance set forth above for its size, a surcharge of the standard landfill rate, per ton, multiplied by a factor of 1.3, will also be assessed.

ANY PERMANENT DUMPSTER HOLDER THAT REQUESTS AN EXTRA DUMP OFF THEIR SCHEDULED DAY PICK-UP WILL BE CHARGED A RATE, BASED ON SIZE OF THE DUMPSTER DIVIDED BY 4 WEEKS IN A MONTH.

DUMPSTER RENTALS

DUMPSTERS MAY BE RENTED FROM THE VILLAGE AT THE FOLLOWING RATES:

If a customer requests a dumpster for temporary use, the bi-weekly rental charge will apply until the dumpster is returned to the Village. A \$100.00 FEE WILL BE CHARGED AT THE TIME OF RENTAL FOR ALL TEMPORARY RESIDENTIAL RENTALS; A \$150 FEE WILL BE CHARGED AT THE TIME OF RENTAL FOR ALL TEMPORARY CONTRACTOR RENTALS. Refuse will be charged FOR EXCESS WEIGHT (OVER 2,000 POUNDS) at EIGHTY-THREE DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$83.26) ~~eighty dollars and eighty-three cents (\$80.83)~~ per ton for in-Village customers, and NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FIFTY-FOUR CENTS (\$94.54) ~~ninety-one dollars and seventy-nine cents (\$91.79)~~ per ton for out-of-Village customers, PLUS A FOURTEEN DOLLAR (\$14.00) WEIGHT FEE. A ~~\$50.00 deposit for all temporary rentals is required upon rental and will be subtracted from final bill.~~ EACH EXTRA DUMP SHALL BE CHARGED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS \$65.00.

(c) Separate fees for additional pickups or items not otherwise set forth in this chapter shall be assessed as follows:



Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure apply as soon as possible to assure that funds are available for current expenditures, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
