ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 09

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF AN EASEMENT ACROSS CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON
COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village of New London hereby approves the grant of a permanent easement to AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc., and its successors, assigns, lessees and tenants for the erection of electric transmission, distribution, and communication lines and appurtenant equipment and fixtures, being, in, on, over, under, through and across approximately 3.530 total acres within certain lands of the Village, and the adjacent right of way, located on Township Road 1601 situated in the State of Ohio, Ashland County, Ruggles Township, Great Lot 1, Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 20 West, The Firelands, otherwise known as Ashland County Permanent Parcel No. L36-0 17-0-000 1 -00, in consideration of a payment in the amount of \$70,600.00. The Village Administrator, Village Fiscal Officer, and their designees, are hereby authorized and directed to execute such easement and such other documents and perform such other tasks as may be necessary to accomplish the same according to law.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure become effective immediately in order to allow this utility project to proceed as soon as possible, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
