ORDINANCE NO. 2024 – 08

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE VILLAGE’S EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK, RELATIVE TO LICENSING
FOR MOSQUITO SPRAYING

Whereas, it is necessary from time to time for the Village to engage in spraying to reduce the local mosquito population; and

Whereas, the State of Ohio Department of Agriculture requires that an individual obtain a license, following training and testing, to perform such spraying; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS


Section 1. That the Village’s “Employee Handbook and Personnel Policies” be, and hereby they are, amended, as follows:

The language at the end of the portion of the Salary Schedule pertaining to the Street & Sanitation Department, as previously enacted, is amended to read as follows:

***IN ADDITION TO THE FOREGOING, ANY EMPLOYEE IN THE STREET & SANITATION DEPARTMENT WILL AUTOMATICALLY RECEIVE:
AN INCREASE OF \$1.00 PER HOUR FOR OBTAINING A CDL DRIVERS LICENSE; AND
AN INCREASE OF \$1.00 PER HOUR FOR OBTAINING SUCH LICENSING FROM THE STATE OF OHIO AS MAY BE NECESSARY, AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYEE TO CONDUCT MOSQUITO SPRAYING ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE.**

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
